MUSIC OF THE UKRAINIAN DIASPORA ARTISTS

МУЗИКА МИТЦІВ УКРАЇНСЬКОЇ ДІАСПОРИ

The development of musical art in the Ukrainian diaspora began after the end of World War I. The Ukrainian diaspora has had significant musical achievements over a considerable period of time. This has led to the emergence of composers, performers, and singers known worldwide.

Among the notable artists, we can single out: Oleksandr Koshyts, Yaroslav Barnych, Andrii Hnatyshyn, Ihor Sonevytskyi, Yurii Fiiala, Mykola Fomenko, Modest Mentsynskyi, Oleksandr Myshuha, Evheniia Zarytska, Zinova Shtokalko, Vasyl Yemets, Hryhorii Kitastyi.

Choral and instrumental ensembles played a significant role in the development of Ukrainian music in the world, especially the choir of Oleksandr Koshyts (1875–1944). This is a Ukrainian choir located in Canada and named after its first conductor. In 1992, the choir was awarded the Shevchenko Prize for the popularization of Ukrainian choral art. Thanks to the diligent work of Oleksandr Koshyts, Ukrainian melodies became popular worldwide and received the title of a unique artistic phenomenon. The story of Mykola Leontovych's "Shchedryk" melody, which the conductor constantly performed, captivating hearts around the world, is a prime example. In the United States, this melody became one of the most popular and is still used in Hollywood films to this day. In the XX century, choral music became a leading industry both in Ukraine and in the diaspora. World recognition of the uniqueness of the musical folklore of the Ukrainian people and the national choral performance of the choirs of O. Koshyts, D. Kotka, M. Antonovych, A. Hnatyshyn determined the cultural role of the choral industry in the formation of national music.

Back in 1919, the performance of the Ukrainian Republican Chapel in Atlanta caused a real resonance and at the same time drew attention to the young Ukrainian republic, which was fighting for its independence on several fronts. The repertoire of the Koshyts choir consisted of folk songs arranged by Ukrainian composers.

A significant role in the development of music was played by orchestras and choirs under the leadership of Yaroslav Barnych (1896–1967), the author of the popular song "Hutsulka Ksenia." He is considered the founder of modern Ukrainian operetta. In total, he created 4 of them. He also wrote songs in the tango genre. He was a composer of the European school and style.

Composers of the Ukrainian diaspora left a significant creative legacy. Andrii Hnatyshyn and Ihor Sonevytskyi are developing sacred music. Yurii Fiiala wrote the «Ukrainian Symphony» and the symphonic poem «Shadows of Forgotten Ancestors» based on the work of M. Kotsiubynskyi, Mykola Fomenko — the operas «Ivasyk Telesyk» and «Marusia Bohuslavka», he sang solo «Love Ukraine».

Among the Ukrainian opera singers who deserve respect, we can single out: Modest Mentsynskyi, Oleksandr Myshuha, Yevheniia Zarytska, Iryna Malaniuk and others. Despite being outside of their home country, Ukrainian musicians continue to actively support the performance of traditional Ukrainian instruments. This characterizes the stability of Ukrainian culture and its desire to preserve and popularize its traditions.

Ihor Sonevytskyi in his work in the USA sought to convey the meaning of the national culture. His style seeks to continue and develop the traditions of Ukrainian classics.

Hryhoriy Kitastyi: Bandura player, conductor, and composer. Led the Taras Shevchenko Bandurist Capella in Detroit and composed works to showcase this traditional Ukrainian instrument.

Musical artists of the Ukrainian diaspora are very important in the development of Ukrainian culture, but in the modern world they are not given enough attention. I propose to introduce classes related to the memory of outstanding people, as well as to show their achievements in modern musical works.

It can be concluded that the musical art of Ukraine had complex stages of development, expanded the list of genres, combined traditions and innovations. The art of music has conquered Ukrainians who are outside the borders of their native country. Other peoples are interested in him, with a special excitement.
