## MEN'S CHORAL SOCIETIES AS A TRADITIONAL FORM OF CHORAL PERFORMANCE IN GERMANY

Чоловічі хорові товариства Німеччини мають свою давню історію та традиції. Цельтеровський лідертафель був першим чоловічим об'єднанням співаківлюбителів, композиторів та поетів, діяльність якого дала поштовх для створення співочих ферайнів (нім. — verein) на території всієї Німеччини та за її межами.

Одним із чоловічих хорових об'єднань (Männergesangverein), яке існує з 1876 року і по нинішній час, є MGV "Frohsinn" містечка Langenstein (земля Гессен). Товариство поставило своїм завданням плекати хоровий спів, виховувати комунікабельність та брати участь у церковних і народних святах. І до сьогодні це залишилося незмінним.

За історію свого існування хорове товариство відчуло не тільки творчі злети, а й падіння. Обидві світові війни вносили перерву в існування колективу, але його завжди вдавалося відновити. Після 90-річчя існування об'єднання, у 1966 році, спостерігалася тенденція до зниження діяльності, не вистачало співаків. Заснування молодіжного хору Langenstein, який також існує до сьогодні та продовжує писати унікальну історію, дозволило поліпшити справи чоловічого хорового товариства, яке у 1976 році відзначило своє 100-річчя.

За часи свого існування чоловіче хорове товариство MGV "Frohsinn" не тільки веде активну виконавську діяльність,  $\epsilon$  пропагандистом хорової культури, а й створило свої традиції, які  $\epsilon$  невід'ємною частиною творчого життя.

У 1977 році керівництвом об'єднання було прийнято рішення побудувати шашличну хатинку (за кошти членів товариства), де у 1981 році відбулося перше святкування «печеня з картоплі». Ця добра традиція, як і багато інших, зберігається й донині.

Великі співочі фестивалі до 120-ї, 125-ї, 135-ї та 140-ї річниці відзначалися багатьма дружніми хорами Лангенштайна. У 1997 році відбулася перша творча поїздка на свято хору, що стало традиційним у діяльності товариства.

MGV "Frohsinn" дуже активний чоловічий хор, який налічує близько 50 активних співаків і приблизн 180 членів товариства. До репертуару колективу входять твори сучасних композиторів, народна музика та церковно-обрядові композиції. Хор являє собою гарну вікову структуру та має чудового керівника в особі Christoph Hohl.

Чоловіче хорове товариство MGV "Frohsinn" має добрі творчі стосунки з іншими хоровими колективами, заради збереження давніх хорових традицій.

### CHINESE MIDDLE SCHOOL CHORAL MUSIC CHARACTERISTICS

#### ХАРАКТЕРИСТИКА ХОРОВОЇ МУЗИКИ В СЕРЕДНІХ ШКОЛАХ КИТАЮ

#### EASYVIRTUALCHOIR.COM PLATFORM AS A DISTANCE LEARNING TOOL

## ПЛАТФОРМА EASYVIRTUALCHOIR.COM ЯК ІНСТРУМЕНТ ДИСТАНЦІЙНОГО НАВЧАННЯ

Working on a virtual choral project involves singers creating separate recordings and then mixing them into a single whole. This process actually ceases to be choral, because during the recording, the singers do not hear each other, cannot ensemble, which affects several components of choral sound: microintonation (tuning within the zone structure), rhythmic synchronization, diction ensemble, dynamics consistency, and to a lesser extent phrasing.

These problems are partially solved by having an "exemplary" recording with a conductor who uses manual anticipatory techniques to control, albeit virtually, the actual performance of each singer. If the conductor's instructions are followed, this is a guarantee of minimal coherence of all the above components and the ability to combine the tracks into one final track without significant problems.

However, when it comes to educational tasks, when in the context of distance learning there is a task not only to obtain the final result, but also to form certain ensemble singing skills in higher education students or even music school students, this method is not very favorable.

Another way to create such recordings is to use overdubbing, when a singer records "over" another recording, focusing on the sound of another person and trying to match them in intonation, dynamics, etc. Such recordings can be made in various programs, ranging from the Audacity audio editor to video editors that allow you to record an audio
